The Indiantown Gap Fish & Game (F&G) Conservation Club is made up of hunters and fishermen whose love of the sport and the outdoors motivates them to maintain and/or improve the region surrounding Fort Indiantown Gap. Programs are in place for the raising and stocking of trout, protecting the hunters and the wildlife of the Gap as well as educating fellow sportsmen on their responsibilities to make this area enjoyable for outdoor activities.

The Club also sponsors events for local Veteran Warriors. The sole purpose of these events is to offer thanks to the Veteran Warriors for the sacrifices they made that help to assure our safety and well being. One of the events is an annual Sportsmen Program that centers on a spring turkey hunt and fishing event.

When: This year's event marks the **Ninth** annual event and is scheduled to be held on Friday, May 4 and Saturday, May 5, 2018.

What: On Friday, each participating Warrior is teamed with members of the club and other volunteers to go on a morning turkey hunt at Fort Indiantown Gap. In the afternoon and evening the participants are able to fish at a stocked lake at the Fort Indiantown Gap, if they so desire.

The second day, Saturday, is a mirror image of the first day, with breakfast, a morning turkey hunt, lunch followed by fishing in the afternoon if they wish.

All meals, lodging, and any needed equipment are provided at no cost to the Warriors.
