Purpose of the PVF

On 11.11.11, the Pennsylvania Veterans Foundation (PVF) was established for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and include:

- To make grants to other recognized charitable foundations and organizations and veterans' service organizations to carry out the charitable purposes of the Corporation.
- To make grants and to undertake charitable programs and projects to assist and support deserving Pennsylvania veterans and their families.
- To assist Pennsylvania veterans in need of shelter and the necessities of living.
- To provide aid, comfort, assistance, and support for Pennsylvania veterans, including veterans of war or armed conflict and peacetime veterans, and their families.
- To help ensure that Pennsylvania veterans and their dependents have access to accurate up-to-date information and assistance to qualify for federal, state, and local veterans benefits.
- To honor the rich history and heritage of Pennsylvania veterans and the contributions and sacrifices of veterans by providing public education and information.
- To solicit and receive grants, donations, gifts, and legacies from other foundations, charitable organizations, veterans' service organizations, corporations, individuals and other entities to carry out the charitable purposes of the Foundation.

Serving All Who Served

The Pennsylvania Veterans Foundation is one of the Commonwealth's leaders in the assistance of Veterans. This is due largely to its unique dual mission; direct monetary assistance of Veterans in crisis and the granting of assistance to grass root, community based non-profits that care for Veterans in a myriad of critical, focused ways.

Since its inception on 11.11.11, the PVF has granted over 1 million dollars to Veterans in crisis situations and to grass root non-profits that assist Pennsylvania Veterans. The PVF has a tremendous and immediate impact on enabling Veterans in crisis situations. Yet it has a far greater reach by administering its goals with partnership of others. This partnership has resulted in thousands of Veterans gaining assistance. It takes a Community to provide the assets and personal attention our Veterans deserve. And to have a long term effect, while building healthy, self-reliant, productive citizens, we need that cooperation and teamwork.
