Your Veterans Affairs (VA) Health Care Team wants to be sure that you stay healthy by receiving your flu vaccine this year.

Free flu vaccine will be available this fall at the Lebanon VA Medical Center, Building 17 lobby, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., during scheduled outpatient appointments and during scheduled walk-in flu clinics. The community VA Clinics will also be offering flu vaccine during scheduled outpatient appointments and scheduled walk-in flu clinics. All Veterans registered with Lebanon VA Medical Center are eligible. Please see the back of this letter for locations and times of the flu walk-in clinics.

If you receive your flu vaccine outside of the VA healthcare system between August 1, 2018, and March 31, 2019, please let us know, so we can update your record. You may do this by completing the information below* and then completing one of these three options:
