DIRECTIONS

From Harrisburg Area:

322 East to 241 North go 2.7 miles, turn right onto Rocherty Road, go 3 red lights, turn left onto Lincoln Ave, go north for about 6 blocks, entrance to VA on right.

Turnpike 76 East to Lebanon/Lancaster Exit (266):

Take 72 North then 2 red lights, at second light make right onto Rocherty Road, go 2 lights then at second light make a left onto North Lincoln Ave., go north 6 blocks, entrance to VA on right.

From Frackville Area (North):

81 South to 72 South to 422 East, make right onto Lincoln Ave, then go South on Lincoln Ave. to stop sign, continue straight ahead 10 blocks, VA entrance on left.

From Allentown Area:

78 West to Route 22 West to 343 South which turns into 7th Street in Lebanon, turn left onto 422 East to Lincoln Ave., turn right go south on Lincoln Ave to stop sign, go straight 10 blocks, VA entrance on left.

From Lancaster Area:

72 North to Rocherty Road, turn right, 2 lights to Lincoln Ave., turn left onto Lincoln Ave., go north 6 blocks, entrance for VA on right.

From Philadelphia Area:

76 West (Schuylkill Express) to Valley Forge Turnpike Entrance, 76 West to Lebanon/Lancaster Exit (266) to Route 72 North, go 2 lights on 72 North, then turn right onto Rocherty Road, then 2 lights and at second light turn left onto Lincoln Ave, go north 6 blocks, VA entrance on right.

From York Area:

83 North to 322 East to 241 North, go 2.7 miles, turn right onto Rocherty Road, go 3 lights, at Lincoln Ave. make left, go straight 6 blocks, VA entrance on right.

From Reading Area:

422 West to Lincoln Ave., make left heading south, stay on Lincoln Ave to stop sign, go straight about 10 blocks, entrance to VA on left.

DIRECTIONS

From the West: Travel Route 422 East. Turn left at Mull Road (McDonald's and Dunkin Donuts on right). Mull Avenue becomes Van Reed Road. Cross over State Hill Road. Continue and turn right onto Papermill Road (Turkey Hill on left). Continue to second red light and make right onto Century Boulevard. Clinic is up hill on right side.

From the East: Travel Route 222 West. Take the Spring Ridge Drive exit. Turn left onto Papermill Road. Continue to red light and make left onto Century Boulevard. Clinic is up hill on right side.

DIRECTIONS

From the North/Harrisburg Freeway (Rt. 581/11): Exit at South 32nd Street/Rt. 15 South. Drive about three miles south on Rt. 15 to the Rossmoyne Road exit. At top of exit ramp, turn **LEFT** onto Rossmoyne Road towards the Rossmoyne Business Park, crossing **OVER** Rt. 15. At first light, turn **RIGHT** onto Louise Drive, and turn right again onto Ritter Road. Take Ritter Road almost all the way to the end. The VA Clinic will be on the right.

From the South (Rt. 15): Take Rt. 15 north to the Rossmoyne Road exit (first off-ramp past the Turnpike entrance). At top of exit ramp, turn **RIGHT** onto Rossmoyne Road. At first light, turn **RIGHT** onto Louise Drive, and turn right again onto Ritter Road. Take Ritter Road almost all the way to the end. The VA Clinic will be on the right.

From the East/West (Pennsylvania Turnpike): Take Exit 236/Rt. 15. Take the Northbound ramp to 15 and go to first off-ramp, which is Rossmoyne Road. At top of exit ramp, turn **RIGHT** onto Rossmoyne Road. At first light, turn **RIGHT** onto Louise Drive, and turn right again onto Ritter Road. Take Ritter Road almost all the way to the end. The VA Clinic will be on the right.

DIRECTIONS

From Lebanon: Take PA-72 South. Turn slight left onto Fruitville Pike/PA-772. Fruitville Pike becomes N Prince Street; N Prince Street becomes Willow Street Pike/US-222-S/PA-272. Turn left onto Long Lane/US-222 S/PA-741. Continue to follow US-222 S/PA-74. Turn right onto Willow Valley Lakes Drive. Make an immediate right into Willow Valley Lakes complex and another right to get to Building 212. Use the South Entrance to the building and take the elevator to the 2nd floor.

From Reading / Denver Area: Take US-222 toward Lancaster/Lebanon. Merge onto US-30 E via the exit on the left toward Philadelphia/Coatesville. Take the PA-462/Lincoln Hwy exit. Turn right onto Lincoln Hwy/PA-462. Take the 2st left onto Strasburg Pike. Turn right onto Millport Rd. Turn left onto Lampeter Rd. Take the 2st right onto Morningside Dr. Take the 2nd right to stay on Morningside Dr. Morningside Drive becomes Gypsy Hill Rd. Turn right onto Beaver Valley Pike/US-222 N/PA-741. Take the 2nd left onto Willow Valley Lakes Dr. Make an immediate right into Willow Valley Lakes complex and another right to get to Building 212. Use the South Entrance to the building and take the elevator to the 2nd floor.

From Gap / Strasburg Area: Take PA-741 toward N Jackson St. Turn right onto Beaver Valley Pike/US-222 N/PA-741. Take the 2nd left onto Willow Valley Lakes Dr. Make an immediate right into Willow Valley Lakes complex and another right to get to Building 212. Use the South Entrance to the building and take the elevator to the 2nd floor.

DIRECTIONS

From Reading: Follow PA-61 North/Claude A. Lord Blvd for approximately 30 miles until you reach Pottsville. In Pottsville, just past the CVS Pharmacy, turn left on E Arch St. and make an immediate right in front of the Dollar General onto Terry Reiley Way. After 500 feet turn left on Laurel Blvd. The clinic entrance will be approximately .8 miles ahead on the right.

From Hazleton: Take I-81 S for approximately 17 miles to exit 124A for PA-61S. Merge onto PA-61S for approximately 6.3 miles and turn right on Mill Creek Ave. Continue straight for .6 miles and turn left on N Centre St. After .2 miles turn right onto Laurel Blvd. Continue straight for approximately .7 miles and the clinic entrance will be on the right.

From Harrisburg: Take I-81N for approximately 36.5 miles to exit 104 for PA-125/Ravine. After exiting, turn right onto Molleystown Rd. and immediately turn left onto PA-125N for 3.8 miles. Turn right on US-209N and continue for 8.5 miles and then turn left on PA-901W for .4 miles. Turn right onto Maple Ave. and continue straight for approximately 2.3 miles and turn right on N 16th St. and after 350 feet make a left on Laurel Blvd. Continue on Laurel Blvd for approximately .3 miles passing the main entrance to the Lengel Middle School. The clinic entrance will be on the left.

From Lebanon: Take PA-72N for approximately 8 miles and take I-81N for 13.5 miles to exit 104 for PA-125/Ravine. After exiting, turn right onto Molleystown Rd. and immediately turn left onto PA-125N for 3.8 miles. Turn right on US-209N and continue for 8.5 miles and then turn left on PA-901W for .4 miles. Turn right onto Maple Ave. and continue straight for approximately 2.3 miles and turn right on N 16th St. and after 350 feet make a left on Laurel Blvd. Continue on Laurel Blvd for approximately .3 miles passing the main entrance to the Lengel Middle School. The clinic entrance will be on the left.

From Hanover: Take Route 30 East to Memory Lane. Go right at the end of the ramp onto Memory Lane. Turn right on Eastern Blvd. Turn right on South Royal St. Turn left into the parking lot. Our clinic is on the first floor to your right as you enter the building.

From Lancaster: Take Route 30 West to Mt Zion Rd (Rt. 24). Go left at the end of the ramp onto Mt. Zion Rd. Turn right on Eastern Blvd. Turn right on South Royal St. Turn left into the parking lot. Clinic is on the first floor to the right as you enter the building.

From Lebanon: Take Route 72 South, to Route 30 West, to Mt Zion Road (Rt. 24). Go left at the end of the ramp onto Mt. Zion Rd. Turn right on Eastern Blvd. Turn right on South Royal St. Turn left into the parking lot. Clinic is on the first floor to your right as you enter the building.

From Harrisburg: Take 83 South to Exit 21-Route 30 East. Take Route 30 East to Memory Lane. Go right at the end of the ramp. Turn right on Eastern Blvd. Turn right on South Royal St. Turn left into the parking lot. Clinic is on the first floor to your right as you enter the building.

From Stewartstown/Shrewsbury: Take 83 North to Exit 19. Go right at the end of the ramp onto East Market Street (Route 462). Turn right on South Royal St. Turn right into the parking lot. Our clinic is on the first floor to your right as you enter the building.
